The Florida Association of Community Health Centers is pleased to offer Continuity of Operations Training at the Annual Meeting. HRSA, FEMA and the FDOH all strongly encourage Continuity of Operations Planning for health care providers to ensure the continuance of essential functions when faced with a public emergency or all hazards event.

This training program has been designed expressly for Community Health Centers to work hand-in-hand with your center emergency plans and will impart knowledge to allow our community to operate far more efficiently and safely during the post disaster recovery mode. Participants will learn basic COOP concepts, terminology and benefits of the plan. They will also see how COOP benefits your facility to continue essential functions and achieve recovery and reduce disruptions to operations and leadership. The second day features a desk top exercise that is compliant with Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program guidelines (HSEEP) to reinforce the previous day's lectures.

A certificate of completion will be provided to all who successfully complete the courses.

Registration for this course is provided as part of the Annual Meeting registration which is completed using the Web-based CVENT registration system.
